TEACHERS	Teachers alternately co-animate and coordinate their training in each group. All our teachers have a "FLE Maîtrise Diploma" (4 years of university studies with 2 years of specialized studies in teaching French as a Foreign Language)		
FG GROUP PLACEMENT	On official starting dates, each new student will do a written and oral evaluation in order to organize the FG groups.		
CERTIFICATE	On the day of departure, each participant will receive a certificate indicating the number of lessons and the duration of the course as well as the level of French reached based on the European Council Reference Grid.
