



Long French (FL)

This program is designed for students who wish to extend their learning period and their knowledge of the French language over a long time. The program is based on the curriculum of preparation for the DELF (Diplôme d'Etude de Langue Française) and gives the possibility of taking the DELF exam in Aix University or any other city and the TCF at IS Aix-en-Provence, depending on the dates. The participants are adults with at least an elementary level (A2) or two years of active French, who want to express themselves with greater ease, for professional or personal reasons.



Objectives FL:

- Acquiring the tools necessary for the development of communicational skills, oral skills most importantly but without neglecting the written skills
- Using these skills in everyday situations
- Facing every type of communication with more ease and confidence
- Benefit from a continuous program over 8 weeks
- Strengthen the work on written skills
- Possibility to prepare for DELF or TCF exam

TEACHERS	Teachers alternately co-animate and coordinate their training in each group. All our teachers have a "FLE Maîtrise Diploma" (4 years of university studies with 2 years of specialized studies in teaching French as a Foreign Language).		
FL GROUP PLACEMENT	On official starting dates, each new student will do a written and oral evaluation in order to organize the groups.		
CERTIFICATE	On the day of departure, each participant will receive a certificate indicating the number of lessons and the duration of the course as well as the level of French reached based on the European Council Reference Grid.
