This course is designed for adults of different nationalities who wish to improve their French communication skills for personal or professional reasons. Students are taught in small groups by our qualified teachers, who create a friendly and dynamic learning environment. The afternoon sessions are in smaller groups to allow the students to go deeper into the cultural and social aspects of contemporary France.

- Obtain fluency and the confidence to communicate in French

- Improve comprehension in the fields of political, cultural and social life in France

TEACHERS	All our teachers have degrees in teaching French as a Foreign Language (FLE) and receive ongoing training to develop their teaching techniques. They alternately lead and co-ordinate the lessons in each group according to your objectives.		
GROUP PLACEMENT	On official starting dates, each new student will do a written and oral evaluation in order to organize groups.		
CERTIFICATE	Each participant receives, on the day of their departure, a certificate indicating the duration and the level of the taken course based on the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR).
