

General French Plus (FG+)

This course is designed for adults of different nationalities who wish to improve their French communication skills for personal or professional reasons. Students are taught in small groups by qualified teachers, who create a friendly and dynamic learning environment. The afternoon sessions are in smaller groups to allow the students to go deeper into the cultural and social aspects of contemporary France.



Objectives:

Morning in FG:

- Obtain fluency and the confidence to communicate in French in everyday situations
- Discover French culture and French society in different ways
- Develop your know-how and social skills in an international environment and in real-life situations

Afternoon in FG+:

- Enhance your linguistic skills with the help of thematic workshops
- Improve your understanding of political, cultural and social life in France
- Improve your pronunciation

TEACHERS	Our teachers have a degree in teaching French as a Foreign Language (FLE) and receive up-to-date training to develop their teaching techniques. They teach the course alternately and coordinate with each other for a precise follow-up according to the objectives of the CEFR grid.		
GROUP PLACEMENT	On official starting dates, each new student will take a written and oral evaluation in order to organize the FG groups.		
CERTIFICATE	Each participant receives, on the day of his or her departure, a certificate indicating the duration and the level of the chosen course based on the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR).
