This course is designed for adults of various nationalities who wish to improve their French communication skills in a professional or personal context. Our qualified teachers lead small groups and create a dynamic and friendly environment for learning. The afternoon sessions in mini-groups allow the deepening of French-speaking socio-cultural skills and knowledge.

- Develop your skills and competences in an intercultural context in communication situation

- Strengthen language skills in the form of thematic workshops

- Improve your pronunciation

TEACHERS	Our teachers have a degree in teaching French as a Foreign Language (FLE) and receive ongoing training to develop their pedagogical techniques. They animate alternately the course and coordinate with each other for a precise follow-up according to the objectives of the CEFR grid.		
FG GROUP PLACEMENT	On official starting dates, each new student will do a written and oral evaluation in order to organize the FG groups.		
CERTIFICATE	Each participant receives, on the day of their departure, a certificate indicating the duration and the level of the taken course based on the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR).
