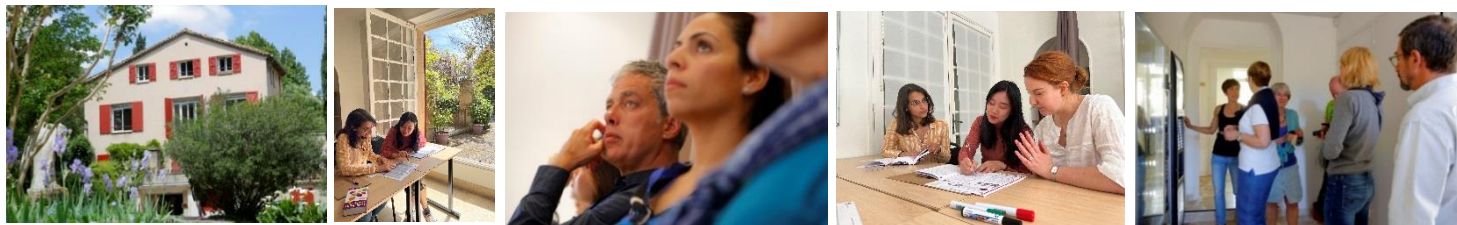


## Long French (FL)

The students are adults who want to improve the four skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) in a professional or personal context. Our qualified teachers lead small groups and create a dynamic and friendly environment for learning.**

- Applying skills in everyday life situations
- Obtain fluency and the confidence to communicate in French
- Benefit from a continuous program over 8 weeks
- To improve written skills

<b>TEACHERS</b>	Our teachers have a degree in teaching French as a Foreign Language (FLE) and receive ongoing training to develop their teaching techniques. They animate alternately the course and coordinate with each other for a precise follow-up according to the objectives of the CEFR grid.			
<b>FL GROUP PLACEMENT</b>	On official starting dates, each new student will do a written and oral evaluation in order to organize the groups.			
<b>CERTIFICATE</b>	Each participant receives, on the day of their departure, a certificate indicating the duration and the level of the taken course based on the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR).
